

## PREFACE

As part of the work programme of the Economic and social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (ESCAP), the secretariat's Population Division has undertaken the preparation and publication of a series of country monographs on the population situation of each interested country in the region. Each monograph is being prepared in close co-operation with country experts and with the financial support of United Nations fund for Population Activities (UNFPA). The present monograph of Nepal is the sixth in the series. The first in Hong Kong, the second on the Republic of Korea, the third on Thailand, the fourth on Sri Lanka and the fifth on the Philippines have been published. Work is in progress on similar studies for Bangladesh, India, Japan, Malaysia and Papua New Guinea. Monographs on other countries will be prepared as the resources of the secretariat permit.
